WHEREAS, said highway traverses a heavily populated residential area, including a school zone, and

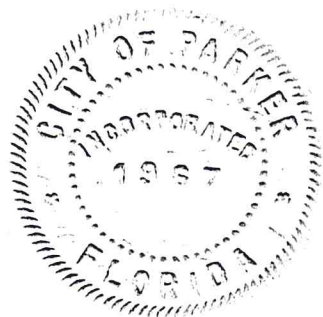
WHEREAS, the present speed limit of 45 MPH is excessive and presents traffic safety hazards along this particular stretch of highway.
