

RESOLUTION 22

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City has been offered the opportunity to participate jointly with the Florida Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration in a Traffic Operations Program to Improve Capacity and Safety on a major part of the highway and street systems serving the greater Panama City urban areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parker has been invited to be a cosignee of a memorandum of agreement to be established between the Florida Department of Transportation and Panama City that will initiate the proposed traffic study, identified as TOPICS; and

WHEREAS, the first phase of TOPICS will be a study to determine the overall traffic operation needs for the area, financed by the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Parker that the City participate in the first phase of the TOPICS program.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the City of Parker participate in the first phase of the TOPICS program and make available, without cost to the State, all available data useful for study purposes.
