WHEREAS, the County has prepared a Subgrant Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto, setting forth the terms and conditions under which said Subgrant is to be made.

## SUBGRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, Bay County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County", has received a grant of Federal Funds providing for the planning and commencement of a program to provide employment to unemployed and underemployed persons pursuant to the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (P L 92-54), and

WHEREAS, the City of Parker

hereinafter referred to as the "Subgrantee", has applied to the County for a subgrant under said program, and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that the application of the Subgrantee is within the purview of the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (PL 92-54) and the supporting Federal regulations, and within the purview of the conditions governing the grant by the Federal Government to the County and that a subgrant by the County to the Subgrantee will serve the purposes of the County, the Federal Government and the Subgrantee.

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the County and the Subgrantee hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The County approves the application of the Subgrantee for a subgrant under the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (P L 92-54). A copy of said application is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Subgrantee acknowledges receipt of a copy of the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (PL 92-54), the conditions governing grant and the applicable Federal regulations and other pertinent documents, all of which are made a part of this Agreement, and the Subgrantee acknowledges that at least one of its supervisory personnel is familiar with said law, regulations and documents and the Subgrantee promises to insure that no provision of said law, regulation or documents are violated by the Subgrantee.

- 3. The Subgrantee shall maintain such documents, records and accounts including property purchased with the nonfederal share, personnel, and financial records, and submit such financial reports as are required by the County to insure a proper accounting of all project funds including the Subgrantees share, as required by Section 55.17 of the applicable Federal Regulations.

  All grant records will be available for audit purposes to the County, the Department of Labor or the comptroller general of the United States and will be maintained for three (3) years after the expiration of this subgrant.
- The Subgrantee shall provide such reports on the 4. number and characteristics of participants, the duration of their employment during the following participation in federally assisted programs, and cost per participant as the Secretary of Labor or the County may direct, including comparable information on other employees or trainees of participating employers. The Subgrantee shall also provide the County such status or progress reports as may from time to time be required and shall specifically insure that representatives of the Northwest Florida Development Council, as liaison agent for the County, such monthly reports as he may require in order to enable him to prepare the monthly grant reports required of the County by the Federal Government and the Subgrantee shall provide such reports a reasonable time prior to the due date of such reports from the County to the Federal Government, the exact due date of such reports from the Subgrantee to the County to be determined by said liaison agent.
- 5. This subgrant is limited by and subject to all conditions, requirements and responsibilities of the primary Federal grant to the County and is subject to modification by the County as may be required to comply with the primary Federal grant.
- 6. All powers with regard to the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (P L 92-54) not explicitly vested in the Subgrantee remain in the County.

- 7. The Subgrantee shall hold and save the Government, its officers, agents and employees, harmless from liability of any nature or kinds, including costs and expenses, for or account of any or all suits or damages sustained by any persons or property resulting in whole or in part, from the negligence, performance or emission of any employee, agent or representative of the Subgrantee and the Subgrantee further shall hold and save the County harmless from liability of any kind, including costs and expenses, for or on account of any act or failure to act which renders the County liable to the Federal Government under the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (P L 92-54).
- 8. The County may terminate this subgrant for cause as specified in Section 55.26 of the applicable Federal Regulations.
- 9. The Subgrantee certifies that any funds received or expended or any action taken by Subgrantee prior to the formal execution of this Agreement was done in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 10. The person signing this Agreement on behalf of the Subgrantee certifies that he has authority to receive and expend funds awarded pursuant to this Agreement for the purpose of the Emergency Employment Act of 1971 (P L 92-54).
