

RESOLUTION NO. 35

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Parker:

WHEREAS, the City of Parker is concerned with the present policies and procedures established by the Environmental Protection Agency and the Florida Department of Pollution Control; and

WHEREAS, the present priority system for financial assistance continues to favor large cities and neglect small cities; and

WHEREAS, small cities and communities cannot afford to comply with present pollution control practices and there is no grant assistance available to them;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress of the United States amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972 to provide for small cities and communities to share in the financial assistance for upgrading and/or constructing new water/sewer facilities.
