BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Parker urge the State of Florida to make every effort to purchase the Baptist Assembly Grounds and preserve the said grounds in their natural state for the recreation and enjoyment of the people of Bay County and other citizens of the State of Florida and our visitors.
