A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BAY  
COUNTY, FLORIDA, CITY OF PARKER

WHEREAS, pending before the United States House of Representatives  
the proposed H R - 9152, and

WHEREAS, H R - 9152, specifically Section 6, would preclude  
Title V Commissions, Districts, and 95% of local governments from directly  
participating in the Federal Excess Government Property Program.

Now, therefore, be it resolved as follows:

1. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Parker,  
Florida deems H R - 9152 to be undesirable and contrary to the welfare  
and best interest of this City and **disruptive** and contrary to the  
principles of practical and effective Federal assistance.

2. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Parker,  
Florida hereby encourages all members of Congress in the State of Florida  
to oppose the passage of H R -9152.

This Resolution is to be forwarded to all members of the  
Congress of the State of Florida.
