RESOLUTION NO. 69

WHEREAS, the City of Parker, herein called the 'entitlement," has thoroughly considered available information from the Florida Council on Criminal Justice:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER, IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED IN THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, THIS 26TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1980, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the City of Parker declares its intent to elect criminal justice entitlement status with the Florida Council on Criminal Justice in order to participate as an entitlement jurisdiction during fiscal year (s) 1981-1983 as prescribed by the Justice System Improvement Act of 1979 (PL. 96-157); and
- 2. That Earl Gilbert, Mayor, be authorized to file in behalf of the entitlement a comprehensive application in the form prescribed by the Florida Bureau of Criminal Justice Assistance for a criminal justice improvement grant; and
- 3. The said Earl Gilbert, Mayor, is further authorized to furnish such information and take such action as may be necessary to enable the entitlement to qualify for said grant.
