

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Parker recognizes the importance of Environmental Protection; and

WHEREAS, any threat to the ecology of the ecosystems within East Bay is a threat to residents of the City of Parker; and

WHEREAS, the contemplated placement of a solid waste landfill at Star Avenue and Tram Road; from which the natural drainage is into East Bay; will place this area in a potentially hazardous ecological posture; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of developing the Star Avenue and Tram Road solid waste landfill site is prohibitively expensive; and

WHEREAS, other options remain open to the Bay County Board of Commissioners;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City of Parker, Florida, that the Commissioners of Bay County, Florida consider a more responsible course of action with the conservation of our natural resources and the economy of cost as primary consideration in selecting the future location of the solid waste landfill.

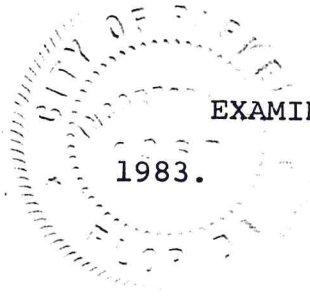
