WHEREAS, George G. Tapper has distinguished himself during a
lifetime of public service, and

WHEREAS, such public service includes being elected to the
Florida House of Representatives in 1947, 1949, and 1951,
and to the Florida Senate in 1953 and 1965, and

WHEREAS, his notable accomplishments in the advancement of the
public good include laying the foundation for the Interstate
Highway System, originating the Florida system of community-
junior colleges, serving as a member of the District Board
of Trustees of Gulf Coast Community College since 1967, and
staunchly supporting the availability of higher education
throughout the State of Florida, and

WHEREAS, he served his country with distinction during World War
II, being highly decorated by the governments of both the
United States and the United Kingdom, and

WHEREAS, his community activities include membership in numerous
service and fraternal organizations, and
