

RESOLUTION NO. 104

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER:

WHEREAS the property owners have immediate plans to sell or develop the property known as the Baptist Assembly Campground. This property being a 21 acre +/- parcel with 725 feet +/- on East Bay and 1060 feet on U. S. Highway 98, and

WHEREAS the property owners have indicated they will give Bay County the first opportunity to purchase the property based on the latest M.A.I. appraised value, and

WHEREAS the Comprehensive Plan of the City of Parker designates this parcel of land to be used as a park and recreation area, and

WHEREAS the City of Parker does not have funds available for this purpose, and

WHEREAS the eastern area of Bay County is experiencing unprecedented growth.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Parker City Council, in recognition of a growing need for recreational areas, requests that the Bay County Commission consider acquiring and developing this property to be utilized as a major park and recreational area.
