RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF
A TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA

On motion of Councilman Davis, seconded by _____
Councilman Boisky, the following resolution was adopted;

WHEREAS, CITY OF PARKER deems it in the public
(Maintaining Agency)
interest to provide for the maintenance and operation of
certain traffic signals along the State Highway System within
CITY OF PARKER, and to enter into the attached agree-
(Jurisdiction)
ment with the State of Florida, Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. That CITY OF PARKER concurs in the provisions
(Maintaining Agency)
of that certain agreement attached hereto, pertaining to the
design, installation, maintenance, and operation of traffic
signals or signal systems along the State Highway System as
identified in the approved "request orders" as provided under
the agreement.
2. That CITY OF PARKER authorizes The Mayor
(Maintaining Agency) (job title or
name of position held) to legally acknowledge and approve
for this Maintaining Agency lists of signalized intersections
and equipment which are contained in any "request orders" from
the Department of Transportation as provided for under the
agreement.
3. That CITY OF PARKER authorizes the said agreement
(Maintaining Agency)
to be executed by a legally designated officer of the Maintaining
Agency.
