A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF PARKER'S PARTICIPATION IN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION, FEDERAL GRANT-IN-AID FUND PROGRAM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER:

THE CITY OF PARKER, A FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, SEEKS TO

BE AWARDED GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL GRANT-IN-AID FUND

PROGRAM AND IN SUPPORT OF ITS APPLICATION FOR A GRANT STATES

AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THE CITY WILL COOPERATE FULLY WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO MAINTENANCE OF FLORIDA'S PRESERVATION PLAN;
- 2. THE CITY HEREBY DESIGNATES THE CITY CLERK AS THE OFFICIAL LIAISON FOR THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA TO EXECUTE ALL APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THIS PROGRAM AND TO SERVE AS THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE IN THE APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATION IN THE GRANT PROCESS; AND
- 3. THE CITY WILL ENSURE AN ON GOING PROGRAM OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION WHICH ENCOURAGES INVOLVEMENT BY ALL SEGMENTS OF THE POPULATION, INCLUDING MINORITIES AND DISADVANTAGED CITIZENS WITHIN ITS CITY LIMITS, FOR THE PLANNING AND SELECTION OF HISTORIC SITE PROJECTS.
