RESOLUTION NO. 120

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER:

WHEREAS, the quality and quantity of groundwater present in Bay County, Florida are of vital importance to the citizens of the City of Parker as well as to all residents of Bay County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, any proposed activities or developments which will probably result in an adverse impact on the groundwater quality or quantity should not be allowed or permitted; and

WHEREAS, the City Council understands that Rajoe Utilities has requested that the Department of Environmental Regulation issue it a permit to allow the effluent of a portable sewer system of a mobile home park to be located in close proximity to Deer Point Lake to be discharged directly onto the ground; and

WHEREAS, if permitted, the the effluent discharge will filtrate into the groundwater system thereby causing a significant detrimental impact on the quality of the groundwater.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Parker opposes the issuance by the Department of Environmental Regulation of any permit for a project which will adversely impact upon the groundwater quality and quantity of Bay County, Florida, including the issuance of a permit to Rajoe Utilities in connection with the proposed mobile home project.
