

RESOLUTION NO. 136

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER RECOMMENDING A REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Panama City Urbanized Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Florida as being the local agency responsible for carrying out the provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134, and Chapter 339.175, Florida Statutes, for urban transportation planning in the Panama City Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, Section 339.175 (3) (a), Florida Statutes, requires that the Governor shall apportion metropolitan planning organization membership every five (5) years with cooperation and agreement of affected local governments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Parker as follows:


SECTION 1. The City of Parker has discussed membership reapportionment and has recommended the following membership:

- 0 5 members to the Bay County Commission
- 0 5 members to the Panama City Commission
- 0 2 members to the Callaway City Commission
- 0 1 member to the Lynn Haven City Commission
- 0 1 member to the Panama City Beach City Commission
- 0 1 member to the Parker City Council
- 0 1 member to the Springfield City Commission


SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
