RESOLUTION NO. 162

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER EXTENDING RESOLUTION NO. 160 RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF ADULT OR DESIGNATED USES; PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATELY EFFECTIVE DATE AND A DURATION OF THREE (3) MONTHS.

WHEREAS, the City of Parker ("City") adopted Resolution No. 160 on Sept 3, 1996, for the reasons set forth therein;

WHEREAS, the City is aware of certain legal challenges to the regulations imposed by Bay County, Florida, on similar adult or other designated uses covered by Resolution No. 160;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned legal challenge that has been filed in federal court is scheduled for resolution shortly after the first of 1997; and

WHEREAS, during the resolution of the litigation, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City, and in furtherance of their health, safety and welfare to extend the time and effectiveness of Resolution No. 160.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PARKER:

- 1. The life and effectiveness of Resolution No. 160 is hereby extended to expire on march 3, 1997.
- 2. Except as modified herein, Resolution No. 160 remains in full force and effect.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
