RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA SUPPORTING EFFORTS OF THE FLORIDA ALLIANCE FOR SAFE HIGHWAYS (FLASH) TO MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY AND SAFETY OF OUR NATIONS TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE BY MAINTAINING TRUCK SIZE AND WEIGHT AT ITS CURRENT LIMIT.

Whereas, ensuring public safety on our roads and highways is a priority of the City of Parker; and

Whereas, the maintenance and integrity of our transportation infrastructure is essential to the prosperity of Florida and safety of its citizens; and

Whereas, additional traffic congestion increases the potential for public safety hazards on our roads and highways; and


Whereas, the utilization of heavier and larger trucks as a mode of transport threatens the infrastructure of our roads and highways and ultimately endangers the lives of our citizens; and

Whereas, the Florida Alliance for Safe Highways, (FLASH), is an organization that supports efforts to maintain the integrity and safety of our nation's transportation infrastructure by maintaining truck size and weight at its current limit;


