

RESOLUTION 97-185

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE TENTATIVE APPROVAL OF AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE UPLANDS PORTION OF THE WASTEWATER TRANSMISSION PIPELINE AND THE WASTEWATER EFFLUENT REUSE PIPELINE, TO LSLT CHURCHWELL, INC., PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN PROGRAM, SUBJECT TO REGULATORY APPROVAL; PROVIDING FOR SUBSEQUENT EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN, OF THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ; PROVIDING A FIVE PERCENT (5%) CONTINGENCY ALLOWANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Parker wishes to utilize funds from the Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program to construct the Uplands Portion of the Wastewater Transmission Pipeline and the Wastewater Effluent Reuse Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 1997, bids were received for the construction of the Uplands Transmission Pipeline and Effluent Reuse Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, Baskerville-Donovan, Inc., the systems engineer for the project has recommended tentative award of the base bid contract to LSLT Churchwell, Inc., in the amount of One million, eight hundred forty three thousand, three hundred fifty and 07/100 Dollars (\$1,843,350.07); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City of Parker tentatively approves the award of the base bid contract for the construction of the Uplands Portion of the Wastewater Transmission Pipeline and the Wastewater Effluent Reuse Pipeline to LSLT Churchwell, Inc., for a total base bid amount of \$1,843,350.07, subject to Bay County securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), and intends to authorize subsequent execution of the

contract documents by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida, after staff reports back to the Board that DEP and all owners have approved such contract .

Section 2. Bay County intends to evaluate those deductive alternatives that may be in the best interest of the joint venture owners.


Section 3. Bay County may negotiate with the City of Panama City for the purchase of its interest in the jointly owned, existing wastewater transmission pipeline along U.S. Highway 98, some 2,200 feet, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000.

Section 4. The City of Parker authorizes by adoption of this resolution, a contingency allowance in the amount of five percent (5%) of the contract amount equaling \$92,168.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Parker, Florida.
