

RESOLUTION NO. 214

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY FUNDS AND PERSONNEL
SERVICES AS CASH AND IN-KIND SERVICES FOR MATCH
TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, PREPARADNESS AND
ASSISTANCE TRUST FUND, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING AS PART OF
THE APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR APPROVAL OF THE CITY OF
PARKER EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMPETITIVE GRANT
APPLICATION, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Parker is experiencing a need for back-up diesel generation powers to operate critical facilities under emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council, of the City of Parker that city staff be able to provide municipal services during and after hurricanes and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the city's City Clerk has obtained contractor and equipment estimates for the purchase and set-up of the city's critical facilities at Parker City Hall/Fire Department/Police Department and Public Works Department with addition of a generator, which equipment and installation will cost approximately \$57,500; and

WHEREAS, costs of procurement of a diesel powered generator is estimated at six thousand eight hundred dollars (\$6,800.00) in staff and expense cost.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA THAT;

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the use of City Administrative Staff, City Public Works Department and other personnel for cash and in-kind services, for an amount not to exceed \$6,800.00 specifically related to bidding, procurement and installation of one diesel powered generator for use by City Hall/Fire Department/Police Department and Public Works Department in the City of Parker.


Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
