A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PANAMA CITY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION VOTING MEMBERSHIP REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN FOR THE PANAMA CITY URBANIZED AREA

WHEREAS, the Panama City Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has been designated by the Governor as the local agency responsible for carrying out the provisions of Part 23, Section 450.306, Code of Federal Regulations and Chapter 339.175(2) and (3) Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Panama City MPO has approved an MPO Voting Membership Reapportionment Plan for the Panama City Urbanized Area to add one (1) additional member to represent the City of Lynn Haven and one (1) member to represent the City of Mexico Beach to the MPO voting membership to increase the voting membership from seventeen (17) to nineteen (19) members apportioned as follows:

- 5 members from the Bay County Board of County Commissioners
- 5 members from the City of Panama City City Commission
- 2 members from the City of Callaway City Commission
- 2 members from the City of Lynn Haven City Commission
- 1 member from the City of Panama City Beach City Council
- 1 member from the City of Parker City Council
- 1 member from the City of Springfield City Commission
- 1 member from the City of Cedar Grove City Commission
- 1 member from the City of Mexico Beach City Council

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Parker, Florida that:

The Panama City MPO Voting Membership Reapportionment Plan for the Panama City Urbanized Area is hereby accepted and approved and said reapportionment plan shall

be submitted to the Governor of Florida for approval.
