

RESOLUTION NO. 07-258

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA SUPPORTING A JOINT LAND USE STUDY FOR TYNDALL AIR FORCE BASE; PROVIDING CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City of Parker ("City") adopted Ordinance No. 06-306 amending certain portions of the Comprehensive Plan the City ("Plan Amendment");

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Affairs ("Department") issued its Statement of Intent regarding the Plan Amendment on July 19, 2006 and published its Notice of Intent on July 20, 2006;

WHEREAS, the Department has filed an administrative proceeding contending that the Plan Amendment is not "in compliance" because it does not adequately ensure the compatibility of land within the City with Tyndall Air Force Base ("Proceeding"); and

WHEREAS, the City and the Department have agreed to settle the issues in the Proceeding which requires the adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 1. The City will support and participate in a Joint Land Use Study for Tyndall Air Force Base ("JLUS").

SECTION 2. The City will send a letter to the Commanding Officer of Tyndall Air Force Base that states the following:

- (a) that the City supports the performance of a JLUS;
- (b) identifies the contact person(s) for coordination purposes; and
- (c) in the event the JLUS is initiated, commit to participation in the process by attending appropriate coordination meetings, facilitating collection of needed information, and providing feedback on recommendations.

SECTION 3. The Mayor or such other person as the Mayor may designate is hereby appointed as the contact person for the JLUS coordination and the person who shall participate in coordination meetings, facilitate collection of information and provide feedback on recommendations. This designation will be included in the letter described in Section 2.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
