

RESOLUTION NO. 09-269

A RESOLUTION OF THE PARKER, FLORIDA, CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND STAFF TO ENTER INTO A HIGHWAY LIGHTING MAINTENANCE AND COMPENSATION AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the **State of Florida Department of Transportation**, hereinafter referred to as the "**FDOT**" find it is necessary for the City of Parker, hereinafter referred to as the **MAINTAINING AGENCY**, to execute and deliver to the **FDOT** the agreement identified as STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM LIGHTING, MAINTENANCE AND COMPENSATION AGREEMENT, hereinafter referred to as the **Agreement**.

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and staff to enter into a Highway Lighting, Maintenance, and Compensation Agreement ("Agreement") with FDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and staff to enter into an agreement with the FDOT for the fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send copies of this Resolution to FDOT and all other persons as directed by the Mayor.



Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof of the City in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sentence, or clause hereof or any provision of this Resolution is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall be unaffected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
