

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-288

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, APPROVING A HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA; PROVIDING REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips abutting Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") rights-of-way areas must be mowed and maintained as directed by FDOT; and

WHEREAS, the Parker City Council ("Council") desires that the City of Parker, Florida ("City") maintain and clean the various rights-of-way areas within the City by mowing; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and staff to enter into a Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") with FDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and staff to enter into an Agreement with the FDOT for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send copies of this Resolution to FDOT and all other persons as directed by the Mayor.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof of the City in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sentence, or clause hereof or any provision of this Resolution is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall be unaffected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
