A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO SUBMIT, ADMINISTER, EXECUTE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING FOR THE CITY OF PARKER; FOR THE **PURPOSE** IMPLEMENTING A NEW FISHING PIER, BOAT RAMP REPAIRS TO EXISTING RAMPS AND A NEW BOAT DOCK FOR DONALSON POINT; AND, IF AWARDED, AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE FUNDS BY THE CITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Parker desires to apply for, submit and administer grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission for the purpose implementing a new fishing pier, boat ramp repairs to existing ramps and a new boat dock at Donalson Point and.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Parker, Florida to formally adopt an official Resolution to approve submittal of the proposed application and to establish its eligibility to participate in the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to submit an application to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission for the purpose of obtaining or acquiring funding to implement a new fishing pier, boat ramp repairs to existing ramps and a new boat dock for Donalson Point.

Section 2. The City of Parker is committed to the project and is in a fiscally and legally responsible position.

Section 3. The City Clerk or designee shall be the official liaison agent and is authorized to accept the funds and execute all further documents for the purpose of administering the program for the City of Parker.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
