

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-367

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA SUPPORTING LOW COST LIGHTING AND AESTHETIC FEATURES FOR THE DUPONT BRIDGE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there are plans for construction of a new Dupont Bridge to be built on Tyndall Parkway;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Parker takes special pride in the presence and support of Tyndall Air Force Base;

WHEREAS, the installation of a new bridge brings the opportunity to create a symbol for our community that reflects the City of Parker and Bay County's pride in our military community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the inclusion of low cost lighting and aesthetic features for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKER, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Parker supports the inclusion of low cost lighting for and aesthetic features in the construction of the new Dupont Bridge.

Section 3. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sentence, or clause hereof or any provision of this Resolution is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall be unaffected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
