SECTION ONE. The Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Final Budget be adopted and approved as the General Fund budget and the Utility Fund budget.

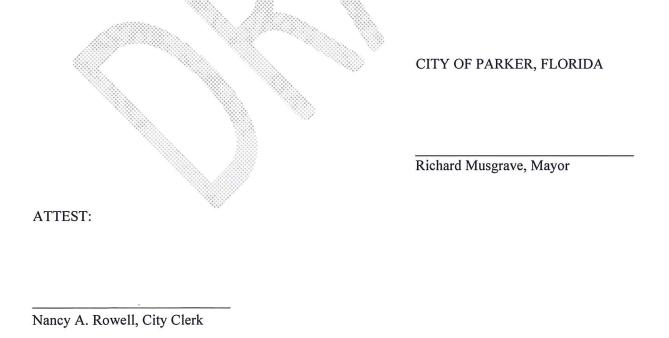
