**REGULAR AGENDA**

1. Fulcrum Group request for temporary building on site- Plans for entire site have been submitted as requested by the planning committee. It was recommended to come before council for approval once submitted. Photos of future for site presented. Building materials for final building have been ordered. Asking for sales trailer and 60' tent for supply sales. Once certificate of occupancy is received, they will build permanent facilities. 8' privacy fence will be built on back and side of entire property backing to homes. Permitting for water retention filed, will begin as soon as allowed. Hope to have trailer and tents removed by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Noise and hours of operation discussed, not open on Sunday and may be open ½ day on Saturday. Noise test conducted at Navarre store and trucks on highway were more of a factor than lumber facility. Assembly plant will be 3<sup>rd</sup> phase and involve inside assembly of windows and doors. Total of about 60 employees and \$20+ benefits, 6 hired already.


**Clerk** – Noticed that the planning committee members of Stryker and Palmer have not been reaffirmed.
