*Pat Fousek of 1344 Stratford Avenue speaks in support of using Peep Park as a classroom/field trip destination by creating more open space but agreed with Ms. Hutto and suggested that it be moved to provide more ground.*

*Ms. Fousek inquires about FEMA money and charging for the use of the parks*

*A discussion ensues among council and the audience*

*Ms. Gibson suggests there may be a workaround but that Mr. Sloan would need to be a part of this conversation*

*Ms. Hutto suggests that the use of a 503c might be a possibility*

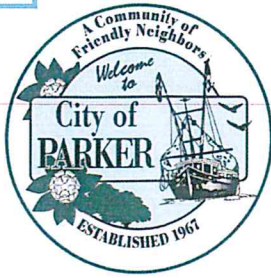
*Ms. Galbreath suggests that we focus on what citizens want as Mr. Sloan is not available to address the legal issues*

*Ms. Hutton suggests that we need to create vandal free items*

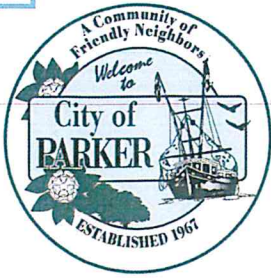
*Ms. Fousek suggests dedication items be used in the park, that we look for grants through the national tennis association and seek help through the school system*
