NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Bids are due on Tuesday, September 3, 2024 up until 2:00 p.m. (CDT).

The following additional questions were received from potential bidders following the release of Addendum 2 and are being addressed below:

1. Please reconsider a state certified Marine Contractors License as State Marine Contracts can and should be bidding on public dredging contracts.

City's Response to Request for Information Question No. 1

As per Addendum 2, a General Contractor's license is required to bid this job.

2. Wet sediment typically cannot go to the landfill because it has to pass a paint filter test. Hydraulic dredging into dewatering bags and/or mechanical dredging will not achieve this. I assumed the ballpark was going to be used as a temporary dewatering site and then hauled to the landfill if need be. Unless the landfill takes wet material, this project is not doable. Please let us know if the landfill will allow wet material or another temporary dewatering site we can use in the city.

City's Response to Request for Information Question No. 2

A dewatering plan was included in the plans allowing for two different options of dewatering the material prior to hauling to the landfill.

3. Who is responsible for tipping fees or are they waved?

City's Response to Request for Information Question No. 3

Per Addendum No. 2, revised Measurement and Payment section, Item D – Bid Items 4 through 11, the Contractor will be responsible for tipping fees.

4. Did the city perform a TCLP and provide that to the landfill? They will not accept it without it. If so, do you have written approval from the landfill?

5. Could tipping fees be an additional line item in a unit of price per ton as that's how the landfill charges rather than included in price per cubic yard?



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City's Response to Request for Information Question No. 5

The tipping fees are included in overall costs of each outfall location (Bid Items 4 through 10) that will be dredged per the revised Measurement and Payment section, Item D – Bid Items 4 through 11. Therefore, no additional line item is needed. Please calculate the tipping cost accordingly.
