

**CITY OF PARKER
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
HELD AT 1001 W. PARK ST, July 21, 2026 – 5:30 PM**

Mayor Andrew Kelly called the meeting to order with Invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following were present: Mayor Kelly, Council Members Tonya Barrow, Katy Bodiford, Ron Chaple and City Clerk Rachelle Stanley. City Attorney Tim Sloan was absent.

ITEMS FROM THE AUDIENCE (Non-Agenda)

1. **Chuck Bodiford - 5405 Fleming Street** – Addressed his concerns about accusations of his name on social media. Encouraged anyone that wanted to ask questions about himself or his business to contact him.

AGENDA

1. **Approval of minutes for 7/7/26** – Motion to approve the minutes with corrections was made by Council Member Bodiford, seconded by Council Member Barrow. Motion was carried with all voting in favor, 4-0
2. **Approval of budget meetings** – Council Member Barrow suggested a second workshop date be added to the agenda. First Budget Workshop will be on 8/17/26, followed by the second workshop (if applicable) on 8/20/26. First Hearing date is 9/10/26, followed by Final Hearing 9/24/26. Motion by Council Member Barrow, seconded by Council Member Bodiford. Motion was carried with all voting in favor, 4-0
3. **Approval and swearing in of New Council Member for Seat #4** – Council Member Barrow explained that the council position is a serious position where serious decisions must be made for the city residents. She thinks Mark Rega would be a good fit for the position. Mr. Rega was the only applicant present. Mark Rega was sworn in by Magistrate Doug Dykes to take Seat 4 on the council. Motion by Council Member Barrow, seconded by Council Member Chaple. Motion was carried with all voting in favor, 4-0
4. **Stevenson, W.P III – 5704/5708/5710 Hwy 98 E** – Approved to combine 3 parcels into 1. Council member Chaple asked about a similar situation where the resident wanted to put the parcels back after they had been combined. Mayor Kelly stated that once combined, the parcels couldn't go back to original until after 10 years. Council member Rega stated that all state requirements were met for this approval. Motion by Council Member Barrow, seconded by Council Member Rega. Motion was carried with all voting in favor, 4-0. Council member Bodiford abstained from the vote
5. **NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Storm Water Management - Tony Summerlin – Public Works Director** – Annual cleanup day is October 10, 2026. On this day, residents are asked to pitch in and clean ditches, culverts, etc around their resident. NPDES has provided several ways Parker residents can participate in helping keep the bayou and bay from pollution. A copy of the notice listing ways to participate was placed on City website by City Clerk.

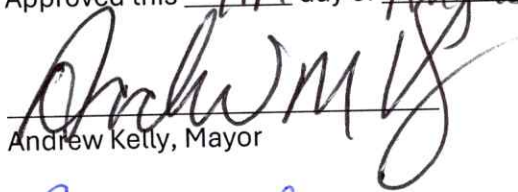
- Monthly yard sale on August 8, 2026, at the Parker Sports Complex, 8am – Noon. The event is growing with more vendors. There is no charge to set up

Council Member Rega

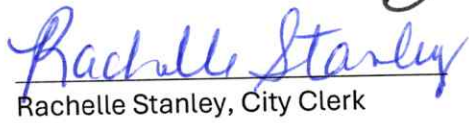
- Thanked everyone for the appointment to his new position
