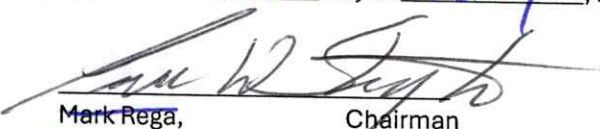

Clearwave Fiber – Tony Signorella (Director of Government Relations), Eric Ryan (Construction Manager), Nicholas Bartelloni (Director of Sales) - 100% Fiber Internet company would like to bring service to the residents of Parker. All equipment is provided with an option should you have your own router. Speed starts at 100 MBPS and go up to 7 Gig. There will be 70,000 feet of underground cable provided to the city. Approximately 2,000-3,000 feet per day will be dug with depth about 24-36 inches underground going into the home. Performance of service during hurricane or disaster remains as the cable can be connected and run from a generator. Cost is less than competitors' and responsiveness is the #1 motto of the company. Clearwave will provide door hangers to residents once approved for construction to begin.

Commissioner Palrang motioned for approval with a second by Commission Merritt. All voted in favor 3-0.

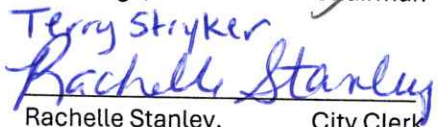
With no further discussion the meeting adjourned at 5:30 P.M.

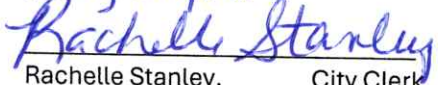
