Mayor Andrew Kelly called the meeting to order with Invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. **Approval of minutes for 8/18/26** – Motion to approve the minutes was made by Council Member Barrow, seconded by Council member Rega. Motion was carried with all voting in favor, 5-0
2. **Changes to the Comprehensive Plan** – Mr. Raymond Greer explained the process for the changes in the Comprehensive Plan. The revised version of the Comprehensive Plan will be transmitted to the state; the state will have 60 days to review from date of submittal. The State will review corrections and accept or add corrections. Once returned from the State, within 180 days changes must be adopted. The second reading of the ordinance would be 60 days later at the following council meeting. Motion to approve the Comprehensive Plan transmittal was made by Council Member Barrow, seconded by Council member Rega and Bodiford. Motion was carried with all voting in favor, 5-0.

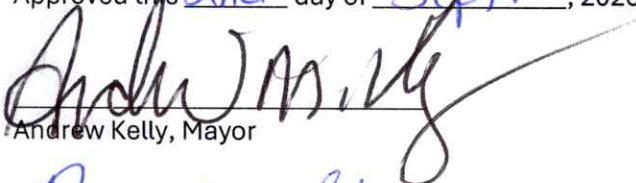
- Monthly yard sale will be September 11, 2026, at the Parker Sports Complex, 8am – Noon. There is no charge to set up.
- Addressed that Parker was listed as the #1 city in the Florida Magazine

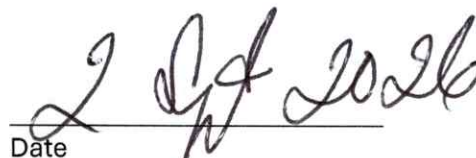
Council Member Rega
